## WIRE TRANSFER FORM - ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

'Beneficiary Bank' means the Bank with which the Beneficiary holds an account.

'Beneficiary' means the intended payee / recipient of the payment.

'BIC' means the internationally recognised Bank Identifier Code.

'IBAN' is the International Bank Account Number that is used to identify the Beneficiary's account. Not all Beneficiary Banks will use an IBAN number.

'Intermediary Bank' means a Bank through which the payment is sent.

'National Clearing Code' is the code that identifies a particular bank and branch.

'SWIFT' is the Society for Worldwide Interbank Financial Telecommunication code.

'Transit number' identifies a specific financial institution.

The customer may provide a maximum of 105 characters including spaces to describe the Payment (e.g. Invoice no. 12345). The Bank will not be responsible for any loss resulting if the number of characters must be reduced within the maximum number.
