

Transfer Money to your RF account using Wire Transfers


In the platform of your bank of choice, add a new recipient to receive funds

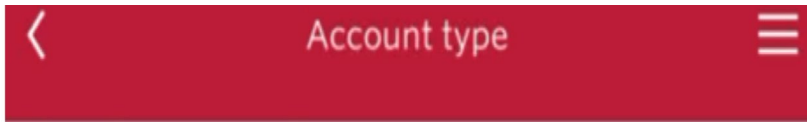
2. The "branch", if applicable, is Head Office.

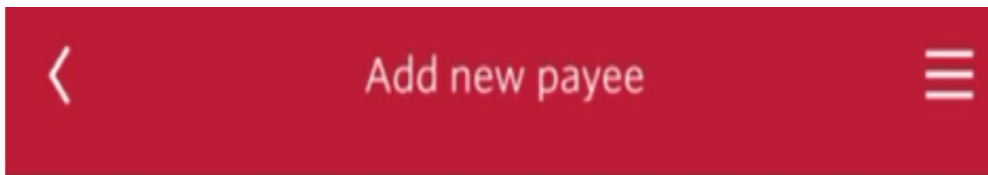
